TENSION HIGH IN GUYANA AFTER PRESIDENT SWORN IN

Political tensions were high in Guyana Saturday, a day after U.S.-born Janet Jagan was hastily sworn in as president just before the country's Supreme Court issued an order to stop the ceremony. Losing presidential candidate Desmond Hoyte accused election commission Chairman Doodnauth Singh of violating the constitution by declaring Jagan the winner while votes were still being counted and without consulting the other commission members.
