- **Formal establishment:** [HIAS](#) established its operations in Guyana in 2020, as indicated by its fact sheet from that year.
- **Earlier history:** The Hebrew Immigrant Aid Society (HIAS) was founded in the United States in the late 1800s to help Jewish immigrants, but its formal work in Guyana began much later.
- **Organizational expansion:** HIAS has expanded its work globally since the 2000s to assist non-Jewish refugees, which led to the establishment of its presence in countries like Guyana, where it provides assistance to various migrant populations. [↗](#)
