Norton troubled over CCJ President's role in Justice Cummings matter

APNU Leader Aubrey Norton revealed yesterday that he was engaged by the Caribbean Court of Justice (CCJ) President Winston Anderson regarding the substantive appointment of then-Chancellor of the Judiciary, Yonette Cummings and he voiced disquiet over this development.

The CCJ President raising the matter with Norton would be seen as interference in a case which has to be decided by the President and the Opposition Leader.

Speaking at a press conference yesterday morning, Norton stated that the engagement has led him to have serious concerns about the court's credibility, declaring, "I will never see them in the same light that I saw them at the inception of its establishment"
