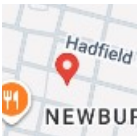


While Kansas has **12 major prison facilities** spanning its state, federal, and military systems, Guyana operates **5 primary prison locations** with a few specific sub-facilities under the jurisdiction of the [Guyana Prison Service](#). [1]

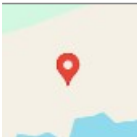
Despite Kansas having roughly 3.6 times the population of Guyana, its prison system infrastructure is significantly larger due to complex domestic federal and military setups.

## Guyana Prison Locations

The Guyanese prison network is centralized into five core geographical locations, managed under the Ministry of Home Affairs: [1]



**Georgetown Prison:** Located on Camp Street (divided administratively into Georgetown A and B).



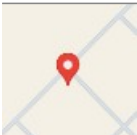
**Mazaruni Prison:** A high-security facility that also includes the **Sibley Hall** prison annex.



**New Amsterdam Prison:** Features separate walled compounds to house both male and female populations.



**Lusignan Prison:** Located in the East Demerara region.



**Timehri Prison:** Located in the East Bank Demerara region. [1, 2, 3, 4]

## Direct Comparison Overview

| Metric                  | State of Kansas                                               | Country of Guyana                                                            |
|-------------------------|---------------------------------------------------------------|------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| Total Major Prisons     | 12 facilities (8 state, 1 juvenile, 1 federal, 2 military)    | 5 locations (encompassing 6 distinct facilities including the female block)  |
| Total Inmate Population | ~8,500 to 9,000 (State level only)                            | ~2,200 to 2,300 inmates nationwide                                           |
| System Capacity         | Generally operates within or near engineered capacity limits. | Historically faces severe overcrowding, regularly exceeding official limits. |
